Circular: 1st National Para Road Cycling Championships at Hyderabad

Dear Sir/ Madam,

I am pleased to inform you that 1st Senior & Junior National Para Road Cycling Championships **will be held at Hyderabad from 11th to 13th Dec. 2024** under the management of Telangana Cycling Association.

The riders will be required to have a valid rider's license for the year 2024 issued by this Federation. **Technical guide shall be shared in due course.**

The dope test will be carried out at random by Dope officials from NADA. Random check will be carried out by CFI officials. The federation also follows the no needle policy and any violation of the rule will be dealt with as per the rules of the UCI/CFI.

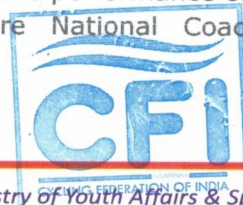
Further it is requested that entries may kindly be submitted to the Federation by **1st Dec. 2024 strictly**. No entry will be accepted thereafter. Blank entry form, list of events & Rider License form are attached herewith for your necessary action. For any further query please contact **Mr. K Dattatraya (Mob. No. 9440484825)**.

It may kindly be noted that the entries will be accepted only through the official email id of the state/ board and only to the below mentioned email id:- paracyclingindia@gmail.com

Kindly note that no boarding/ lodging and local transportation will be provided. All the participants have to arrange their own accommodation and transportation.

Other details of the event are as follows:-

1. The 1st National Para Road Cycling Championship, 2024 is being hosted by the Telangana Cycling Association under the aegis of the Cycling Federation of India (CFI). The technical support will be provided by Aditya Mehta Foundation and the competition will be conducted as per UCI Rules & Regulations. All results shall be uploaded on CFI website and the performance of Cyclists shall help in their selection for future National Coaching Camps and International Competitions.



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2. All races will be conducted together as per category wise (C1 - C5). However the final timings will be considered as per category wise and results will be declared. A State/U.T./Team can enter in one age group and in one disability class. The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) reserves the right to make any change/s in the programme, if necessary for administrative convenience. The age categories are under 17 years, 21 years and Elite category. The decision of the LOC in all matters pertaining to competition shall be final and binding.
3. The Cyclists should carry their Para Cycling Riding license, which can be received from the CFI affiliated State / UT units after Registration, and produce for license check at the time of entry confirmation during Managers Meeting.
4. The entry of the Cyclists should have been received through the CFI affiliated State/U.T. Units by 1st Dec 2024.

5. Championships Details:

Venue	: Service Road, ORR Medchal, Hyderabad.
Date	: Thursday, 12th Dec 2024
Time	: 0700 hours
Race Format	: Individual Time Trial
Race Distance	: 13 KMs (may vary depending on road)

Team Managers Meeting will be held on 11 Dec 2024 at 4.00PM. The event communique will be published in advance. All team managers and athletes are required to attend. It is the responsibility of the teams/athlete to be familiar with the event rules and regulations.

6. Rules of competition:

- Rules will be those of Cycling Federation of India (CFI) and Virtus Sivus India, which are based on the rules of Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).
- All athletes are required to purchase personal insurance.
- There will be no upper age limit for athletes to participate.
- Competition will be held separately for Junior & Seniors.
- Competition will be held separately for both Men & Women.

7. Eligible Categories:-

- C1 - C5 : Athletes with class C riding bicycle
- H1 - H5 : Athletes with class H riding handcycle
- T1 - T5 : Athletes with class T riding Trike bike
- CII 1 : Athletes with Intellectual Impairment

8. Classifications:

Athletes with Physical Impairment competing in the National Championships will have their category determined by both Medical and



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Technical classifiers.

- Any athletes not previously classified or listed on the UCI Master List must attend a classification session on Wednesday, 11th December 2024 at the designated place.
- Medical classification will be conducted by Dr. Asha Shaikh, and technical classification by Mr. Aditya Mehta.
- Participants are required to submit the Medical Diagnostics Form (MDF) along with relevant medical documents by 1st December 2024 to paracyclingindia@gmail.com, dattu1012@gmail.com and ashashaikh003@gmail.com. More information on UCI's classification process & guidelines can be found [here](#).
- For Classification, the cyclists should bring:
 - Medical Diagnostic Form ([MDF](#)) typed-filled, signed and sealed by the Doctor.
 - Cycling Riding License, which can be applied through State/UT associations
 - Original Aadhar Card,
 - Original Date of Birth Certificate, and
 - Disability Certificate as issued by the Govt. Authorities.

Athletes with Intellectual Impairment (Category CII 1): - should be certified by Virtus- World Intellectual Impairment Sport (earlier known as INAS) and produce a certificate from Virtus Sivus India (affiliated Indian body to WIIS) at the time of classification that the athlete belongs to CII 1 Class. Strict adherence to Virtus Eligibility Guidelines and Criteria is required for participation.

- All cyclists must be pre-approved by Virtus Sivus India and registered with the Cycling Federation of India (CFI). Applications for new cyclists should be submitted to Virtus Sivus India at least one month prior to the Championship. Athletes not approved by Sivus India are not ineligible to compete.
- For athlete eligibility inquiries, send an email to eligibility@sivusindia.org. Make sure to follow the eligibility guidelines when submitting athlete documents. For any clarifications and details **Mr. Aaron Benjamin, Country Director SIVUS India may be contacted on 9108227023.**

9. Accommodation: Athletes and teams have to arrange their own accommodation. LOC will suggest the nearest hotels/accommodation options nearer to event location.

10. Decision & Protest Rules: The decision of the committee shall be final and binding to all. For any disputes or complaints, athletes must present their concerns to the Protest Committee on race day. It is the athlete's responsibility to resolve the matter with the Protest Committee on the same day; no issues will be considered after the event has concluded. The Protest Committee's decision is final and must be accepted by the athlete. The Para Committee with

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the following members would be responsible to the conduct of the event with the technical support from the CFI. All disputes/ queries and jurisdiction shall lie with the Para Committee:-

12.IMPORTANT / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- a. Attending Medical Classification by all newly entrant Cyclists is compulsory.
- b. Athletes / teams found guilty of manipulating the age and / or percentage of disability shall be debarred from participation in the National Championship for one year or more.
- c. No Athlete/official/coach/manager/parent shall go/speak to the Print or Electronic Media without prior and proper prior permission from CFI.
- d. Personal photography at the Competition site shall be permitted only under written permission from CFI and of those individuals who are involved in the photograph/video.

It is requested to kindly adhere to all guidelines strictly for smooth conduct of the event.
